



English Language and Literature Teacher – American International Section

About the role

The American International Section of the Lycée français international Simone Veil is seeking an English Language and Literature teacher for the 2023-2024 school year. This position covers at least two Language and Literature classes in the Section, as well as additional hours covering English as a foreign language in middle and/or high school. The classes in the Section are taught at a native level and focus on close reading and the development of written expression through English-language literature. Although the curriculum for the final two years of high school is in part set by the AIS council, individual teachers have a high level of autonomy and responsibility in building units and the teaching around the given texts.

The ideal candidate for this position is an experienced and engaging teacher who can work independently in building a curriculum and lesson plans while also coordinating well with the rest of the American Section team.

This is a full-time position starting in September 2023, with a higher proportion of hours in the Section itself expected in future years as the program expands throughout high school. Additional hours teaching History-Geography in the Section may also be considered based on teacher and course availability.

Requirements:

- A relevant undergraduate degree from an accredited university, preferably in the United States of America
- If degree is not from the United States, relevant experience with US pedagogy
- Minimum of two years' teaching experience in English or relevant work experience in education
- Native-level English proficiency
