





Joining the PA means playing an active part in the success of our students. It contributes to strengthening the spirit of belonging to a dynamic international school!

The Lycée français international Simone Veil is a private school under agreement with the AEFÉ. As such, it is under parental management (PA).

The school's parents' association and patrons (Verein der Eltern und Förderer des französischen Gymnasiums in Düsseldorf e.V) was founded in 1976. The association is managed by a Management Committee (Vorstand), which is the association's executive body and comprises 6 to 10 members - volunteer parents elected from among the association's members.

The members of the PA meet once a year at an Ordinary General Meeting to elect their representatives to sit on the Management Committee, to present the annual accounts and to vote on the budget and school fees for the following year. It is the managing body of the school and is legally responsible under German law.

School revenue comes mainly from tuition fees paid by families.

The Parents' Association covers the salaries of locally recruited staff, as well as a contribution to the salaries of resident staff, and covers all operating costs (utilities, maintenance of premises and educational expenses).

The French government contributes to the school's development through the partial remuneration of resident staff (civil servants recruited by the AEFÉ), scholarships for certain students, and one-off equipment and operating grants.



The Management Committee manages the school administratively, financially and legally in partnership with the school management (special regulations). It defines the budget, sets tuition fees, manages the school's real estate and personal property, and recruits local staff in conjunction with the Headmaster.

The Management Committee meets regularly to discuss and take management decisions, with an advisory board made up of the school's Headmaster, the Primary School Headmaster, the Administrative and Financial Director and, by invitation, the French Consul General and a representative of the French Embassy in Germany.

Any parent can become an active member of the Association (see Association application form) and apply to the Management Committee to take part in the running of the school.

The Management Committee presents the financial statements and the budget for the following calendar year to the parents at the General Meetings. The parents who attend the meeting take part at the voting process. The financial statements approved at General Meetings are available to members of the Parents' Association and may be consulted by the school's financial officer.
