ESCRIME - BEGINNERS

Students will experience 'real combat' with electric scoring equipment, and all will compete in friendly matches against other international schools.

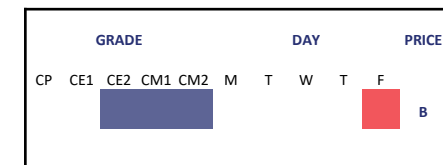
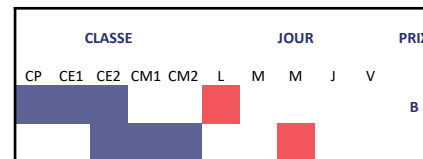
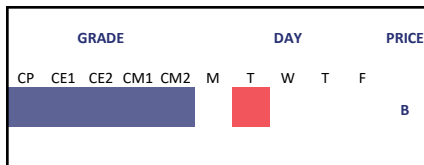
They will have fun creating pouches, bags, accessories, comforters and decorative pillows. Once the creation is finished, they can take it home.

Registration and Payment Terms

All registrations must be made through Eduka, in the module dedicated to APS.

Registrations are on an annual basis. However, in specific cases, mid-year registration may be possible (e.g., a student joining the school mid-year or a change in the family's schedule).
Each workshop has a limited number of places. Once the limit is reached, the activity is considered full; a waiting list may be created.

There are no prerequisites for registration; children may sign up for as many workshops as they wish (no limit on the number of activities).
We will make every effort to accommodate all families. However, each workshop will only take place if a minimum number of participants is reached, and each activity also has a maximum number of participants.
Invoices will be issued after the workshops have started.

Please note that supervision for primary school students is provided until 5:30 p.m. only. The child is under the responsibility of the parents from the moment the child leaves the after-school programme (4.00 pm, 5.30 pm or 6.00 pm).

Absences

If your child is exceptionally unable to attend an activity, please inform the coordinator in advance by email (aps@lfisv.de). This helps avoid unnecessary concern for the instructors.

In the event of a one-time absence of an instructor, a solution will be provided during the scheduled session time (e.g., a substitute instructor, supervision in the library, participation in another workshop, etc.).

In the case of a prolonged or repeated absence of an instructor, make-up sessions for the missed workshop will be offered.
